

Volunteer Details

- Volunteer Days: Wednesday – Saturday
- Project Type: New Construction
- Dates: September through May availability, as requested by sponsor
- Time: 7:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Volunteers and future homeowners collaborate to construct the exterior or “shell” of the home.

Tasks include:

- Building and raising walls
- Installing hurricane straps, clips, blue board, windows, and doors
- Raising roof trusses & installing fall protection system
- Installing exterior Tyvek insulation wrap
- Decking and singling

Interior work and other specialized tasks are completed by skilled subcontractors or experienced volunteers. Once construction is complete, sponsors and volunteers are invited to a home dedication ceremony to celebrate with the future homeowners.

Additional Information

- Houston Habitat provides all tools, materials, personal protective equipment and drinking water.
- Sponsor provides lunch, snacks, and beverages other than water. Sponsors may also choose to provide t-shirts.
- Lunch is 11:00 – 11:30 a.m.
- Appropriate attire should be modest, comfortable clothing that can get dirty. Closed-toe, closed heel shoes are required.
- All volunteers must be age 16 or older. Minors require parental permission.

Playing house sparks children to think about what home means to them.



Partner with Houston Habitat for Humanity to build a playhouse and provide kids a place to foster their creativity and leadership through pretend play.

- Pledge to sponsor a playhouse
- Select dates with a Houston Habitat staff member
- Identify volunteers (10 per playhouse)
- If you have a charity you would like to receive the playhouse, let us know. Or we will assign your playhouse to a family or charity on our waitlist.
- Houston Habitat will notify you of any theme preferences from the recipient
- Get with your team and design the playhouse theme, we will provide the base colors
- Work together for 4 to 5 hours, building and painting
- Present your playhouse to the recipient

Our construction staff will guide your team and provide the materials and equipment. Volunteers may bring decals, stencils, or special items to create a special design.

With a contribution of \$3,500, you or your group can sponsor a playhouse.

Your support will facilitate imaginative play - helping children develop social, language, and problem-solving skills and your gift will enable more Houston families to obtain safe, stable, affordable homes.
